Why Bayside Dynamo?

- Bayside is an affiliate of the Houston Dynamo, a professional soccer team that provides real exposure to professional
 level training and development opportunities. The Houston Dynamo is in the MLS and has been in existence for 6
 years. The Dynamo won the MLS cup, the pinnacle of soccer in the USA, in their first 2 years of existence. The
 Dynamo was in the finals of the MLS cup again last year. We are a professional scouting club that sends our elite
 players to the Houston Dynamo Academy, which may place players directly into the MLS.
- Coaches are all professionally licensed and experienced youth soccer coaches. Many have played and/or coached at the professional and or collegiate level.
- Director of Coaching, Coach David McCarthy, is one of the most respected youth coaches in the Southern US. He has
 over 500 professional games, coached at the University of West Florida, spent 20 years as a HS Head Coach
 (Pensacola Catholic 12 yrs, West Florida Tech 8 yrs and currently Gulf Breeze HS) and has coached numerous select
 teams at a multitude of age groups. Coach McCarthy also holds the USSF "A" Coaching License and the English
 Football Association "A" Coaching License.
- Director of Technical training, Coach Fraga DaRosa, who is regarded as one of the best technical trainers in Northwest Florida. Every team will have a weekly session with Coach Fraga.
- Many age groups have more than one team which provides for three primary benefits:
 - Allows for top-level players a greater opportunity to train and compete with other top-level players. This also allows all players to develop in an environment that is based upon the team's skill level rather trying to force all players to attempt to train either above or below their current skill level.
 - Additionally, it allows for players and families that have a greater commitment to soccer development to be
 on a team of like minded athletes, while those players and families that are committed to playing in a more
 competitive environment but are just not at that high level of commitment are afforded the opportunity to
 still play select soccer with a premier organization with professional level training.
 - Finally, multiple teams create a tremendously incentive driven environment so players have a reason to compete in every practice and every game.
- Elite Level Playing Opportunities with the super select club partnership. Our club is collaborating with six other select soccer clubs in Northwest Florida. These clubs will create super teams at various age groups to compete in four very high-level college showcase tournaments to gain greater exposure for the elite level players.
- Foundations Program for the development of our younger players. Additionally, this program is run by professionally licensed coaches to ensure that the players are trained and exposed to a well-rounded soccer curriculum. We know that a solid basis of soccer technical skills is the future of our club and soccer in our country.
- Goalkeeping training Every team will send two players to receive specialized weekly goalkeeper training at no
 additional cost to the individual or the team. Not only does the individual keeper benefit from this training but the
 entire team benefits by having a fundamentally sound keeper in the net.
- College Camp The club is bringing together a group of college coaches for the older age groups to provide additional exposure to possible scholarship and collegiate playing opportunities.
- Tournaments Bayside pays the entry fee for teams into two tournaments per year and has free entry for Bayside teams into the tournaments that we host.
